

Gear List

The following is a list of items recommended for you to bring to camp in order to be prepared for a week of challenging activities and fun. (Suggestion: make a check mark next to each item as you lay out your equipment and then cross it off after you have it packed.) **All gear must be clearly labeled with the scout's name.**

Clothes

Uniform (class A and class B)
Shorts
Long Pants (*needed for snow sports and swimming*)
Socks (multiple pairs recommended)
Short Sleeve Shirts (class B t-shirts)
Long Sleeve Shirt (**needed for swimming merit badge**)
Sweatshirt or *fleece pullover*
Underwear (*more than 1*)
Swim Trunks
Sneakers or Lightweight Boots (*NO open toe shoes!*)
Hat
Scout Belt
Water shoes (for showers and lake activities)
Pajamas

Bedding

Cot or Pad * (**Cot recommended**)
Sleeping Bag and/or Sheet and/or Blankets
Pillow

Towel and Washcloth
Soap in a Box and Shampoo
Toothbrush and Paste
Comb
Deodorant and Talcum Powder or Goldbond
Prescription Medication *

*Medicines must be turned in to the Troop 26 medical officer. Refer to **medication document** for details.
