Previous Meeting Minutes

Dennis reviewed the minutes of the November 2008 meeting. Printed copies of the minutes were available at the meeting. The minutes can also be obtained from the Member's section of the troop website.

Action Review: Bill believed the March campout date had been set as the 13 thru 15th. We will not be able to arrange a Cosmosphere trip this year. No action was reported on any other items.

Following a motion by Bo and a second from Wayne, the minutes were approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report - Randy McGuire

Randy provided the Treasurer's Report, dated February 5, 2009. The package included November-December 2008 and January 2009s Receipts and Expenditures Report, and Cash Status Reports as of 12/31/08 and 1/31/09. The report package is included as an attachment to this document. Randy summarized the reports and led the discussion. Lettered callouts highlight notable items.

Nov-Dec

2008 receipts over expenditures was approximately \$10,000.

Ian Parker was the top fall 2008 Blue and Gold seller earning \$325. The troop earned \$1125, scouts received \$2554. The next sale starts on 2/16/09.

Jonathan Hodge was the top popcorn seller earning \$508. The troop earned \$2380, scouts received \$6740. There were 17 non-sufficient funds checks totaling \$1694, all but \$89 had been collected.

134 Scouts and 76 adults paid dues and were rechartered.

Jan

A Jamboree payment of \$32,000 is due in July 2009. The total Jamboree fees will be \$845 per person. The Jan 2010 payment will be \$67,600.

Randy will have a summer camp schedule available on Monday

The report was approved unanimously.

Chairman's Agenda

The group asked for the disposition of the recent Honor Court session. Bill reported it was a payment for repairs and a suspension. Repairs have been made. Bill and Ted will contact the affected parents to obtain repayment to the troop.

2010 Jamboree

Committee members expressed an urgent desire to learn the estimated cost of the Jamboree trip. Discussion followed. The bus cost and Jamboree fees were identified as the two largest items. Discussion of the Special Activities Fund and scholarships followed.

February 5, 2009

Page 2

Bo made a motion to allocate \$20,000 from the special activities fund to the 2010 Jamboree. Specific use of the money will be determined at future meetings. Gerald seconded the motion. During discussion Dennis Z expressed concern over an allocation with no report from the Jamboree committee. Wayne supported that perspective. Mike suggested a Jamboree Fund Raising dinner. The need to estimate the overall trip cost as soon as possible was recognized. The motion carried with two no votes and no noted abstentions.

Recognition

Gerald made a motion to reimburse Bill for the \$100 he gave to Carol James in recognition of the Court of Honor and Arrow of Light work she does for the troop. Bo seconded the motion which was approved unanimously.

Chairman's Items

Randy reported he has stopped asking the adults that were not rechartered due to not having a background check, when they were going to complete the check paperwork. Ted asked for the names of the Assistant Scoutmasters that are involved.

Ted asked for volunteers to help load, deliver, and return the troop museum for the Court of Honor. Bill Shaffer, Ted, and Mike Sturm volunteered. Gerald and Jim Gonders stated they would help take down and return everything the after the court.

Scoutmaster's Items

Jimmy Kaczmarek was elected as the next Senior Patrol Leader.

Troop leader business cards - Carol has produced a template. Do we want them for the active leaders? There was general support for the cards.

Court of Honor – This court will include the special awards. The first half will be the rank and Eagle Scout presentations, there will be a break, and the second half will include the special awards. Robert will pass on the Dubie Jar.

Council Banquet – Bill does not like the combined Eagle and Silver Beaver banquet format. But he will be there and expects it will be “pretty cool”.

Jamboree Troop Leadership – Bill led a discussion on the adult leadership of the Jamboree troops. He has obtained approval to take five men per troop resulting in 35 scouts and 5 men per troop. The men chosen will be active campers, BSA trained (Wood Badge will be asset), and active in other areas of the scouting program. There are 23 troop men that have paid the Jamboree deposit. There are also national staff opportunities. There was also a discussion of using Matthew Cradock as an SPL. Bill later reconsidered that decision and will review the SPL candidates.

Adult Leader Service Committee

Bo is helping Jaimie, Terri, and Donalyn build a spreadsheet to collect troop leader tenure and training information.

Troop Equipment – No report

Fundraising

Ted reported that a troop Garage Sale is planned for the fall.

Bo – Dr. Miller's ranch in Lenopah needs some weeding work in the spring. Dr Miller said he would pay scouts for their work. Bo will call Dr. Miller to determine what is needed.

Don Hull Jr. described an Interstate Battery sales program for scouts. Only a few troops in the area have sold the products. Popcorn averages 35% income, this would be 50%. A comparison of an equal number of sales indicates this would be nearly twice as profitable as popcorn sales. Don had called a Dallas troop and will get some details on their program. Don offered to chair this project and continue to manage the popcorn sales.

New Business

Denis K described the new BSA medical form. It replaces all Class 1, 2, and 3 forms and must be used in 2010. This year the new or existing forms may be used. Bo made a motion supporting use of the new form from here forward. JJ seconded the motion which was approved.

Bo asked that Summer Camp be added as a standing agenda item at this meeting. Cost for 2009 will be \$180 per scout, \$115 for adults. Some rope and other material will be needed.


