

# Camp McClintock

- Location** Approximately 14 miles west of the junction of US 75 and US 60 near Bartlesville. There is a sign on the south side of highway 60 at the turn-off to the camp. After the turn bear right each time the road forks.

- Campsites** There is a large field which may be used for camping. There are shaded campsites near both ends of the field. There is a small pavilion and a large dining hall that can be reserved.
- Water/Toilets** A central pump provides potable water. Spigots are located near each campsite. Outdoor latrines are available.
- Program** The camp has a small pond, a suspension footbridge and a deep creek suitable for wading and swimming. The area is excellent for hiking. The large field is well suited for games.
- Arrangements** Camp McClintock is property of the Cherokee Area Council. 121 E. Adams Blvd., Drawer U, Bartlesville, OK 74005 918-336-9170. Camping arrangements should be made with the council. A Tour Permit is required.
