## Scouting for Food Drive 2015

**Who:** The Boy Scouts of America & Community Food Bank of Eastern Oklahoma

**What:** The Boy Scouts of America's food drive called "**Scouting for Food**" that benefits the Community Food Bank of Eastern Oklahoma.

**Why:** To increase efforts in serving food to the those individuals and families in need by restocking the food bank after the busy holiday season. Many people know that the Community Food Bank of Eastern Oklahoma serves not only Tulsa neighborhoods but the whole eastern side of Oklahoma. What many people don't realize is that after the holiday food drives the food banks are nearly empty. **The Boy Scouts of America would like to help with this dilemma and increase efforts in replenishing the food banks after the busy holiday season.**

**Where:** Tulsa Metro Area and surrounding cities.

**When:** The food drive will begin **February 7 & 8** with Scouts going through neighborhoods and placing bags with fliers attached on door steps. One week later on **February 14<sup>th</sup>** between **9AM and NOON**, the Scouts will return to the neighborhoods to pick-up the bags full of food where all food donations will be delivered to the nearest drop-off location for the Community Food Bank of Eastern Oklahoma to pick-up.

### Examples of items to Consider Donating:

- Peanut butter
- Canned chicken and tuna
- Soups, stews and chilis
- Canned fruits and vegetables
- Cereal
- Rice and pasta

### Examples of items we CANNOT accept:

- Food that is homemade, home-canned or previously opened
- Unlabeled products or a product not in its original packaging
- No perishable food, alcohol, medicine or sodas
- Rusty, dented cans
- Outdated product
- Glass containers
